- (a) T: Deploy to MTC with at least three fuel tankers. P: To facilitate STX operations.

- (a) T: Coordinate with SFC Bell to ensure that there are at least five ambulances manned at MTC for the exercise. 3 will be with the rotating platoons, one at the 9mm range/rappel tower, and one at the BAS. P: To facilitate training operations.

**d. Coordinating Instructions.**

**(1) Collective Training Lanes.** (see Annex C).

- (a) **Summary.** Additional Information from OPORD: There will be three platoons formed to rotate between the three STX training lanes. Each company will provide a slice of soldiers and vehicles to form these three platoons, so that we have three similar, task-organized platoons. Each of these platoons will be led by a PL/PSG team selected from one of the units. See Annex A and C. 91W tasks will also be evaluated during the execution of the STX lanes.
- (b) **Personnel.** Specific lane O/C's have been identified in the training matrix. Those O/C's will be responsible for running and controlling their entire lane, including coordinating the other personnel and equipment requirements. O/C's and units must submit a roster of support personnel to SFC Kuzel NLT 7 May 04, which includes all personnel to be present and which personnel will have duties precluding them from participating as a platoon member. SFC Kuzel and SFC Mashaw will publish a consolidated roster of which personnel are assigned to which location/STX platoon.

- (c) **Equipment.** It is imperative that each unit convoy as many vehicles to MTC as possible, to maximize the number of vehicles available for the STX platoons. Each unit must coordinate with and submit vehicle rosters to SFC Kuzel and SFC Mashaw as soon as possible. SFC Mashaw will publish the final vehicle roster which will determine which vehicles will be assigned to which location/STX platoon.
