WHO MAY APPLY:

Open to all Illinois Air and Army National Guard Officers in the grade of O5 (Promotable) and O6. This is a T10 tour. T32 USC 708. The Adjutant General will submit all nominees to CNGB for approval.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of: **O5 to O6**. Individual selected will receive an AGR tour with National Guard Bureau. **In order to be considered for this position, applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below WILL be submitted AS A MINIMUM. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief memo will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position. 1. Illinois Army National Guard (ILARNG) Military Tour Checklist.
2. NGB Form 34-1 - Application for Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) Position.
3. Copies of last 5 Officer Evaluation Reports (OER's) if applicable. If 5 are not available, submit all available OER's and a letter of recommendation from your Unit Commander.
4. Soldier Talent Profile (STP) - Must have photo and all PII Redacted. Dated within 90 days of the announcement. (ORB still suffice)
5. ANG: Complete Copy of Report of Individual Personnel (RIP) within last 30 days. RIP can be obtained from the servicing Force Support Squadron (FSS). In lieu of a RIP, applicant may provide a printout from the Virtual MPF (VMPF). Select 'Record Review', and then 'Print/View All Pages'.
6. DA Form 5016 - Retirement Accounting Statement. Must be dated within the last 90 days.
7. All DD Form 214's/NGB Form 22's.
8. Individual Medical Readiness Record (IMR) dated within the last 12 months. Do not submit a screenshot of the homepage of your MEDPROS profile.
9. ANG: IMR Printout (This can be found via the AF Portal, "My IMR/ASIMS – Medical Readiness" – screenshot the initial IMR page with current overall statuses)
10. DA 705 or applicable AFT and HT/WT documentation
11. ANG: Report of Individual Fitness from My Fitness with a minimum passing score of 75 within the last 12 months (prior to the closing date of this announcement)
*Must have been pulled from My Fitness within the last 6 months, and include your name and fitness history.
12. Copy of Valid Permanent Profile (if applicable).
13. AF Form 422, Physical Profile Serial Report (CURRENT within 12 months), must include PULHES (this is not your PHAQ).
14. DD Form 5500 (male) / DD Form 5501 (female) - Body Fat Content Worksheet (if applicable).
15. Biographical Sketch.
16. Memorandum to the Selecting Official addressing any aspect of your application (if applicable).
17. Combine all documents into 1 PDF file; No attachments within the pdf file, no portfolio files, no .tif files, and no .jpg files will be accepted.
18. Naming Convention for Application: Vacancy Announcement #, Last Name, First Name, Rank

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: **01A**

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must meet the initial eligibility requirements of AR 135-18, Table 2-1.
2. ANG: Member must meet all eligibility criteria in ANGI 36-101, Air National Guard Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Program.
3. Applicants must satisfy the requirements outlined in NGR 600-5, NGR 600-100, NGR 600-101, NGR 600-200, NGR 601-1.
4. ANG: Member must hold the required AFSC or be eligible for retraining to the required AFSC and meet all eligibility criteria in the AFECDA/AFOCD.
5. Applicants must meet the Army medical retention standards in accordance with AR 40-501, Chapter 3.
6. Applicants must meet the Army Body Composition Program (ABCP) body fat standards in accordance with AR 600-9.
7. Applicants must meet the security clearance requirements of the position.
8. Applicants must have a passing Army Combat Fitness Test (ACFT) or Army Fitness Test (AFT) taken within the last 12 months.

9. ANG: Air Force Fitness Standards. AGR Airmen are subject to the provisions of AFI 36-2905, Fitness Program. Airmen must meet the minimum requirements for each fitness component in addition to scoring an overall composite of 75 or higher for entry into the AGR program. For members with a documented DLC which prohibits them from performing one or more components of the Fitness Assessment, an overall "Pass" rating is required.
10. Applicants for commissioned officer positions must complete the specialty compatible with the duty position and become qualified in the appropriate Area of Concentration (AOC) within 12 months of assignment or will be removed from the Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) program.
11. Applicants must not be subject to flagging actions during selection or upon entering an Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) status.
12. Applicants must have no derogatory information within their Official Military Personnel Record (OMPF).
13. Applicants must have no record of conviction by special or general court-martial or civilian courts of offenses listed in AR 27-10 (Military Justice), Chapter 24, or otherwise required to register as a sexual offender under AR 27-10, Chapter 24.
14. Applicants must be able to complete a three (3) year tour of active duty prior to completing eighteen (18) years of active federal service, unless waived by the National Guard Bureau (NGB).
15. Applicants may not be a candidate for an elective office, hold a civil office, or be engaged in partisan political activities if selected to enter the Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) program.
16. Applicants who have voluntarily resigned from the Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) program in lieu of mandatory or involuntary separation action are not eligible to reenter the AGR program in accordance with AR 135-18.
17. Applicants who have voluntarily separated from the Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) program for one or more days are not eligible to reenter the program for one year from their date of separation, unless waived by the National Guard Bureau (NGB) prior to the announcement closing date
18. Qualified by character, ability, experience, and education in the fields of financial management, federal acquisition, and federal logistics management.
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BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

CNGB advisor to TAG. Supervise the acquisition, supply, and accountability for Federal property issued to the National Guard. Receipt and account for all funds and property of the U.S. in the state for which he or she is the USPFO. Make returns and reports concerning those funds and property, as required by the Secretary concerned. Provide financial and logistical resources for the maintenance of Federal property in the possession of the National Guard of the State (32 USC 10503). Furnish advice and assistance to units, organizations, and activities within the State to ensure that Federal funds and property are used in conformance with applicable laws and regulations. Operate fiscal station(s), receive Federal funds and maintain fiscal accounting records for all Federal funds as prescribed by DA, DAF and NGB directives. Operate the ARNG logistic support systems in accordance with paragraph 4a, AR 130-400 and operate the AF Standard Base Supply System IAW chapter 17, Sect 17b, paragraph 17.6.2.2, AFMAN 23-110. When directed by CNGB, coordinate, under proper authority, federal mobilization, transportation, finance, logistics, purchasing and contracting actions, and inter/intra service agreements for Joint Operations. Additional Appointed duties include as the Federal Small Business Local Competition Advocate, Transportation Officer, Certifying Officer, Grants Officer, Artifact Responsible Officer (ARO), and as the NAF Fund Manager. All other duties as assigned.
